## Outstanding Exhibitor Awards Criteria – Horse Projects

### Age divisions:

Senior – ages 15-18 (as of January 1)

Intermediate – ages 12-14 (as of January 1)

Junior – ages 8-11 (as of January 1)

*\*Age divisions are the same across all species*

- **Outstanding Exhibitor Exam (OEE) (35%)** **30 POINTS**  
Member receives 30% of their total OEE score (out of 100 points). All exam content will come from your species resource book. Sign up online for a time-slot to take the Exam. Exams will be taken on **July 11<sup>th</sup>** at the Wayne County Fair Event Center. Scores will be converted to a percentage to 2 decimals. (i.e. OEE score of 95 = 28.50 points.  $95 * 30\% = 28.50$ ). Online sign-up form for timeslots will be available on the Extension Office website starting early June and a link sent through the 4-H News and Notes email update.
- **Project Record Book (10%)** **10 POINTS**  
Member receives a score out of 10 for an updated project record book. Book will be judged for content. **Turn in books August 8<sup>th</sup> from 6-9 pm at the Wayne County Fair Event Center.**
- **Showmanship (30%) Showmanship Class #** \_\_\_\_\_ **30 POINTS**  
*Please list which showmanship class you would like to use for the points. Your points come from your placing in the class with a max of 30 points*

- **Performance Class Placing (30%) Performance Class #** \_\_\_\_\_ **30 POINTS**  
*Please list which performance class you would like to use for the points. Use the class you feel your horse performs well in, this can be any class but showmanship. Your points come from your placing in the class with a max of 30 points*

1 <sup>st</sup> place = 30	6 <sup>th</sup> place = 15	All others = 1 points
2 <sup>nd</sup> place = 27	7 <sup>th</sup> place = 12	
3 <sup>rd</sup> place = 24	8 <sup>th</sup> place = 9	
4 <sup>th</sup> place = 21	9 <sup>th</sup> place = 6	
5 <sup>th</sup> place = 18	10 <sup>th</sup> place = 3	
- **Participation in outside activities BONUS** **(up to 10 bonus POINTS)**  
There will be bonus points based on how many fun shows you have attended this year or if you participated at the Ohio State Fair. With a maximum of 10 points. If you participated in fun shows you will get 3 points per show and then 1 additional if you attend 3 or more fun shows.  $3+3+3+1 = 10$ . If you participated in the Ohio State Fair you will receive 10 bonus points. If you participate in Skillathon and or project interview judging you can also receive 3 points for each of those events. Participation form must be filled out for each activity and submitted online at <https://go.osu.edu/wc23oebonuspoints> by September 1 at 4:30 pm. ## **Frequently Asked Questions**

### **How do I sign up for Outstanding Exhibitor?**

To be considered eligible for this award, you must take the exam on July 11<sup>th</sup> and make an entry via Fairy Entry by August 1st

### **What if I cannot attend the July 11<sup>th</sup> test date?**

Please contact the Extension Office on or before July 11<sup>th</sup> to schedule a make-up time to complete the exam.

### **What do I study for the exam?**

All content is pulled directly from your species resource books.

### **My child has a learning disability and I am concerned that an exam will affect their score negatively.**

We will have readers available if they are requested before July 11<sup>th</sup>. For potential other accommodations please contact the Extension office.

### **Will the Outstanding Exhibitor Exam count for Skillathon?**

Yes, if you complete the Outstanding Exhibitor Exam it will count as completion for your Skillathon requirement!

### **I have two breeding animals. Which score do you count?**

We take the higher of the two scores to count toward your total. (Dairy has their own ODE specific class)

### **How do you break ties?**

1<sup>st</sup> the test score, 2<sup>nd</sup> the book score, and 3<sup>rd</sup> the showmanship score

### **When will the awards be presented?**

For 2023, all OME, OBE, ODE, and OHE awards will be presented at the fall 4-H Recognition Banquet on November 9<sup>th</sup>.

### **How many people will be awarded?**

A total of 11 youth per species will be awarded. The top 2 overall can be from any age division, and then the top 3 from each age division (junior, intermediate, senior) will receive awards.
