To: 4-H and FFA members with Goat/Sheep Carcass Projects

*Please read the following and, if you have questions, please call!  
Refer to your Junior Fair Carcass show rules and requirements for more information.*

**Live Show:** We will have the live show on Saturday, August 26<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 a.m. in the Show Arena on the Wayne County Fairgrounds. Trucking after the show to 3D Meats is provided. Weigh in for carcass goats and lambs will be between 8:00am and 8:45am. Goats must weigh a minimum of 60 pounds, lambs must weigh 100 pounds at check-in to be eligible to place. If the goat or lamb is underweight, it may still be processed and graded but it will not be ranked in the results show.

**Carcass Show:** The viewing of the carcasses will be on Wednesday, August 30<sup>st</sup> at 6:00 p.m. at 3D Meats Facility in Dalton! 3D Meats 14740 Lincoln Way East, Dalton, OH 44618. All carcass goats and lambs WILL BE processed at 3D Meats.

**DUNF Forms:** A Drug Use Notification Form will need to be completed for your carcass animal. These will need to be done between **August 23<sup>rd</sup> and August 25<sup>th</sup> by 4PM** online at <https://go.osu.edu/2023waynedunf>

**Project Records:** Keep your records in a 4-H livestock feed record book or FFA SAE documents, along with records on any other goat you may be raising.

**Selling your carcass goat/lamb:** If you are going to pre-sell your goat or lamb to someone, make your buyer aware that if your animal wins Grand or Reserve Champion, it MUST sell at the fair. *(Please note Champions will be sold at the fair and will not go back into the family's custody.)* Any member who does not claim custody of the carcass within 30 days of the contest will not be allowed to participate in the contest the following year.
