



Details



- Friday June 23, at the Wayne County Fairgrounds Coliseum
- Starting at 9am
- Registration cost \$20 per person or \$40 per family
- Lunch will be provided

What to expect



- Arrive with your calf and be ready to go at 9am
- The clinic will include a clipping demonstration, so animals will need to be clean and dry at the start of the clinic
- In the morning there will also be a nutrition, and wash demonstration.
- The afternoon will consist of the showmanship clinic

What to bring



- Need to bring your project calf or heifer (no milk cows)
 - You may borrow calves or heifers but we recommend you bring your own project
- Supplies such as clippers, top-line blower, top-line brush, hay, shavings, water bucket, show halter
- Other items that may be helpful- hose, wash brushes, soap, fly spray
