Dear Beginning Sewer:

As a 4-H member enrolled in the *Sew Fun* project you are invited to join us for 3 days of sewing fun at a ***Beginner Sewing Camp June 14 - 16*** from 8:30 a.m.-12:00 p.m. **OR** 1:00-4:30 p.m. at Fisher Auditorium, OARDC, 1680 Madison Ave., Wooster.

At *Beginner Sewing Camp*, you will learn about basic sewing equipment, how to use a sewing machine, measurements & pattern fitting, pattern layout, clothing construction and much more. Members of the Building 10 Committee, Master Clothing Educators and other volunteers will help you complete your *Sew Fun* project from start to finish.

The camp is limited to a minimum of 5/maximum of 10 participants per session (a.m. or p.m.). Preference will be given to those attending the camp for the first time. If you wish to participate, you must register online at <https://go.osu.edu/2022wcsewingcamp>. The cost is \$20.00 which you may pay online. If you prefer, you may also pay with cash, check or money order *payable to OSU Extension*). Registration deadline is **June 1st**; registration is not confirmed until payment has been received online or at the Extension office. After you have registered, you will receive a confirmation packet which will include medical forms, a list of items you'll need to bring with you and other details about the camp.

To participate in the Sewing Camp you will need to choose one of the following patterns, which is included in your registration fee. You will receive your pattern the first day of the camp.

Skirts – Simplicity #1334*, #1786, #8807, or #8961

Shorts – Simplicity #1520*

Capris – Simplicity #2469*

Pants – Simplicity #1520*, #2290*, or #8672*

Please be sure to indicate your pattern choice when you register.

If you attended one of the Pattern & Fabric Selection Clinics at JoAnn Fabrics in April your fabric selection has already been approved. If you did not attend a Pattern & Fabric Selection clinic, please contact Marcia Brueck at 330-347-5118. If you are not participating in the sewing camp, you should choose a pattern for skirt, shorts, or pants with a complete elastic waist that is labeled 'easy' or 'simple' or 'learn to sew'.
