As a 4-H member enrolled in the *Sew Fun* project you are invited to join us for 3 days of sewing fun at a *Beginner Sewing Workshop* June 13-15 *OR* 20-22 from 8:30 a.m.-12:00 p.m *OR* 1:00-4:30 p.m. These workshops will be held at Lackman's Sewing Center, 164 Church Street, Apple Creek, Ohio 44606. Please note Lackman's Sewing Center has moved!

At this workshop, you will learn about basic sewing equipment, how to use a sewing machine, measurements & pattern fitting, pattern layout, clothing construction and much more. Members of the Building 10 Committee and other volunteers will help you complete your *Sew Fun* project from start to finish.

The workshop is limited to a maximum of 6 participants per session (a.m. or p.m.). Preference will be given to those attending the workshop for the first time. If you wish to participate, you must complete the registration form on the next page and return it with your registration fee of \$15.00 (make checks or money orders payable to OSU Extension) to the Extension office by June 1st. After you have registered, you will receive a confirmation packet which will include medical forms, a list of items you'll need to bring with you and other details about the workshop.

To participate in the Sewing Workshop you will need to choose one of the following patterns, which you will receive the first day of the workshop.

Boys must use the McCalls #M6972 or Buttericks #B3475

- basic elastic topped shorts

Girls must use Simplicity 2469, 1334, or 1786

–elastic topped skirts

On your registration form please mark which pattern you would like!

For participants we are offering an orientation "open house" from 4:30-7:00 p.m. on Thursday, June 9 at Lackman's Sewing Center in Apple Creek. Come at your convenience during those hours to be acquainted and become familiar with the location. Please bring your fabric to be approved at the open house. If you attended the Pattern & Fabric Selection Clinic at JoAnn Fabrics in April your fabric has already been approved. You may still attend this orientation meeting if you would like. If you did not attend the Pattern & Fabric Selection clinic and are unable to attend this orientation meeting, please contact Dorthy Lackman at 330-698-3060.
