



**OSU Extension Wayne County  
Summer 4-H Assistant Position**

**Qualifications:**

2015 college student with an interest in working with people preferred. Strong written and oral communication skills, organizational skills and teaching skills highly desired. Preference will be given to individuals majoring in an agriculture-related field, communications, or education and to individuals with 4-H or FFA experience. Candidate will need to successfully complete a BCI fingerprint background check prior to employment with OSU Extension Wayne County.

**Job Responsibilities:**

Individual will have diverse responsibilities, including, but not limited to:

- (65%) – Assisting 4-H Educator and 4-H Program Assistant with planning, organizing, and conducting summer 4-H programs, activities, and events such as cloverbud day camp, food and fashion board meetings, junior camp, junior fair board meetings, livestock clinics, teen camp, skillathon, summer horse fun shows, and project judging events.
- (10%) – Assisting with preparing Ohio State Fair project area packets for county winners selected to advance to State Fair competition and assisting with preparing summer organizational advisor packets.
- (10%) – Assisting with data entry, drafting correspondence, preparing letters, mailings, forms, newsletters, and reports as needed.
- (15%) - Assisting with general office support as needed (answering phones and providing customer service to walk-ins).

**Position Duration:**

15 weeks at 40 hours per week, beginning on or about May 17 (exact start date is negotiable). Some evening and weekend work included. Some possible as-needed work through December may be available, hours and days negotiable.

**Wages:**

Wages of \$8.10 - \$10.00 per hour based on previous work experience
