

BE AWARE OF THE OVERNIGHT POLICY!

Staying overnight during the Wayne County Fair is STRONGLY discouraged. However, if a member MUST stay, then the following rules apply:

1. No children under the age of 9 years will be allowed to spend the night.
2. Children from age 9 - 14 must be accompanied at all times by a parent or legal guardian during the night and no more than 2 children can be with any one parent/guardian.
3. Children aged 15 years to 20 years will be permitted to spend the night in a building accompanied by either :
 - Any adult 21 years of age or older, on a one-on-one basis; or
 - A parent or legal guardian with no more than two children with one parent or legal guardian.
4. All those staying overnight must be in the barn in which they are staying by 10:00 PM and remain there, or they will not be permitted to stay.

Members must complete an overnight form as they have in the past. The form is available on the 4-H website. **Must Be Returned to the Extension Office By September 1st.**

Absolutely no overnight forms will be accepted after September 1st.
