- 3. Should have an agricultural background and show continued interest in the agriculture industry. Special consideration will be given to those with a dairy background, 4H or FFA dairy involvement or employed by a dairy based business.
- 4. Should have plans to pursue a career in agriculture.

Any person who meets the above requirements and desires to apply for the scholarship must:

- 1. Complete the application and submit it by deadline date.
- 2. Have the high school submit a transcript of all credits earned.

 If you have attended educational programs beyond high school, have the school submit that transcript also.
- 3. Be willing, if requested, to meet with the selection committee for a personal interview.
