GUIDELINES FOR 4-H ENDOWMENT GRANTS WAYNE COUNTY

- 1. Eligibility to apply for a grant will be open to any 4-H advisor, 4-H volunteer, 4-H staff person, 4-H club, or organized 4-H council or 4-H committee in Wayne County.
- 2. Funded proposals for workshops, clinics, program enhancements, etc. are not eligible the following year to receive an endowment grant or scholarship. New and innovative proposals have a higher priority.
- 3. Anyone receiving a grant or scholarship (i.e. a grant or scholarship for a workshop or clinic or a program enhancement) is expected to share what they learned or what the program gained within the county. This could be done by holding a workshop, visiting 4-H clubs, 4-H extension committee, and/or by written or audiovisual materials.
- 4. All educational programs conducted by Ohio State University Extension are available to clientele on a nondiscriminatory basis without regard to race, color, creed, religion, sexual orientation, national origin, gender, age, disability or Vietnam-era veteran status.
- 5. Receipts for all expenses incurred will be submitted to the Wayne County 4-H Extension Committee for review.
- 6. The Awards/Recognition committee of the Wayne County 4-H Committee will review all applications and recommend recipients to the whole committee keeping the total within the budget limits of the endowment fund limits.
- 7. The deadline for all applications is June 1st to the Wayne County Extension Office by closing time (4:30 p.m.)
