Dear 4-H and FFA Goat Exhibitors;

Congratulations on enrolling in a market goat project this year! This letter contains very important information about your project, so please read it carefully. *Also, be sure to read the project guideline sheet found in your 4-H project record book.*

**To be eligible for the 2016 Wayne County Junior Fair,
ALL MARKET GOAT PROJECTS MUST BE TAGGED:**

SATURDAY, JUNE 4, 2016

8:00a.m. -10:30a.m.

Wayne County Fairgrounds-Coliseum

This is the ONLY date that market goats will be tagged and tattooed for the fair! You do not have to be present, but your goat must be at the Coliseum between 8:00am and 10:30am on June 4 to be eligible to show or sell at the Wayne Co. Junior Fair!

Due to Scrapie Eradication Program, all goats including breeding and market must have a premise I.D. ear tag (please see project guideline sheet for list of approved Scrapie identification).

Market goats must have their Scrapie tag in their ear by the June 4th Tag-in. If your goat does not have a Scrapie tag, see your breeder or vet before the June 4th Tag-in.

Also, this year's 4-H / FFA Goat Clinic will be held on Saturday June 25, 2016 from 10 am – 12 noon in the Coliseum at the Wayne County Fairgrounds. Quality Assurance Training, Skillathon Information, Pack Goat Course practice, and information about health, showmanship, and much more will be presented during the clinic.
