Dear 4-H and FFA Market Lamb and Breeding Sheep Exhibitors;

Congratulations on enrolling in a market lamb or breeding sheep project this year! This letter contains very important information about your project, so please read it carefully. Also, be sure to read the project guideline sheet found in your 4-H project book.

**To be eligible for the 2016 Wayne County Junior Fair  
ALL MARKET LAMB PROJECTS MUST BE TAGGED  
Saturday, June 4, 2016 • 8:00am - 10:30am • Wayne County Fairgrounds-Coliseum**

This is the ONLY date that market lambs will be tagged for the fair! You do not have to be present, but your lamb must be at the Coliseum between 8:00am and 10:30am on June 4 to be eligible to show or sell at the Wayne Co. Junior Fair!

Registration papers on purebred breeding sheep must be available to a sheep committee member at the fair. Members who do not comply will be unable to exhibit their animals and animals will be dismissed from the fairgrounds, unless slick shorn and weighed-in for the slick shorn ewe lamb or yearling class.


Due to Scrapie Eradication Program, all lambs including breeding and market must have a premise I.D. ear tag (please see project guideline sheet for list of approved Scrapie identification). **Market Lambs must have their Scrapie tag in their ear by the June 4 Tag-in.**

**New for 2016**

**Both the Market and Breeding shows will follow the swine shows. The shows will start no earlier than 3 pm.**
