


The form must be filled out with all information requested, including the photo of the animal.

Please attach a good, clear photo of the RIGHT SIDE of your calf (see example below). Make sure your animal is clean before taking the photo, or it could create a problem in the event of trying to identify your calf. Firmly attach your photo below over the example given.





To identify the RIGHT SIDE of your calf, stand behind your calf looking toward its head. The side of the calf to your right is the RIGHT SIDE to be photographed.

Feeder calves must be born after January 1st of the current year.
