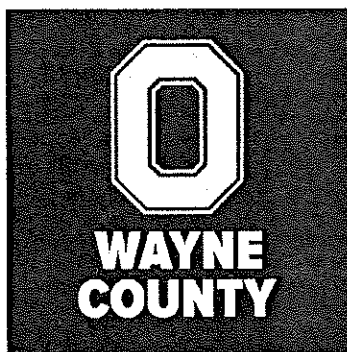
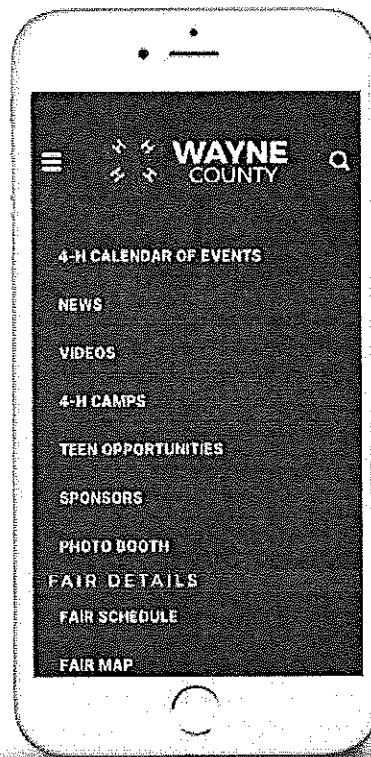

Order of Show

Showmanship Classes

Both Purebred and mixed breed dogs can be shown in 4-H Showmanship Classes. The dog is judged on both its appearance and its performance in the ring. In addition to obeying commands to heel, stand and turn, it must look alert and be well groomed. The dog is being judged on condition, grooming and temperament, as well as the way it moves. Showing in this class requires just as much careful preparation as does showing in obedience class.

Participants are judged on :	
Interview	60 Points
Handler appearance and attitude	50 Points
Grooming	40 Points
Handling (individual and in group)	<u>80 Points</u>
Total possible points	230 Points

Senior Showmanship	Members 15 - 18 years of age as of January 1 of current year.
Intermediate Showmanship	Members 12 - 14 years of age as of January 1 of current year.
Junior Showmanship	Members 9 - 11 years of age as of January 1 of current year.
Beginner Showmanship	First year dog exhibitors at fair, any age.

Obedience Classes

Both purebred and mixed breed dogs can show in Dog Obedience. The dog and handler are judged on the dog's reactions, behavior and general obedience to the handler's commands. The dog should obey the handler without anticipating commands or appear resentful. Both are also judged on appearance.

An example of one class...

Participants are judged on:	
Heel	45 Points
Figure 8	25 Points
Stand for examination	30 Points
Recall	40 Points
Long sit (1 minute)	30 Points
Long down (3 minute)	30 Points
Appearance and sportsmanship	<u>30 Points</u>
Total possible points	230 Points

Rally Classes

Both purebred and mixed breed dogs can show in Dog Rally classes. Rally is a sport in which the dog and handler complete a course that has been designed by the rally judge. The judge tells the handler to begin, and the dog and handler proceed at a brisk pace through a course of designated stations, 10-20 depending on the level. Each of these stations has a sign providing instructions regarding the next skill that is to be performed, via words, directional arrows, colors, and geometric shapes. The dog and handler team moves continuously at a brisk but normal pace with the dog under control at the handler's left side. There should be a sense of teamwork between the dog and handler both during the numbered exercises and between the exercise signs; however, perfect heel position is not required. After the judge's "Forward" order, the team is on its own to complete the entire sequence of numbered signs correctly.

Participants are judged on:

Correct completion of course	100 Points
Appearance and sportsmanship	<u>30 Points</u>
Total possible points	130 Points

Rally Novice B – open to all members who have completed 4-H project #201-O and have previous Rally experience.

Rally Novice A – open to all members who have completed 4-H project #201-O who are 1st year Rally competitors.
