COVID-19 Frequently Asked Questions

- **No 4-H gatherings: Has the “no 4-H gatherings” been extended from April 20 to May 15?**
 - Yes, clubs, county, and state events are not allowed to meet in person until after May 15. As an office we are not allowed to reschedule anything until after May 15 either. Our office will not be posting rescheduled dates until at least May 15.
- **Member Enrolment: when is enrollment due?**
 - April 1 is our target enrollment date for all returning members and advisors. And June 1 is the target enrollment date for new members and advisors. We understand that complications can arise, we will do our best to accommodate the needs of the clubs, advisors, and members, we ask that you contact us with any circumstances where these deadlines cannot be met.
- **Animal ID: is animal ID still due June 1?**
 - Yes, animal ID aligns with the state animal possession date that is regulated by the ODA. At this time the ODA has not adjusted the possession date, the possession date is state law. If you communicate with us any circumstances that would prevent you from aligning with this due date, we will do our best to help you.
- **Club Documents: Are club documents still due April 1?**
 - No, we have extended the deadline for club documents such as club charter, constitution, by-laws, etc. due to June 1.
- **Activity Fee: How do I pay the activity fee if the office isn't open?**
 - You are welcome to mail your activity fee to the extension office (checks only, no cash) or wait to pay it until the office re-opens. To mail it send to: OSU Extension Wayne County 428 W. Liberty Street Wooster Ohio 44691. Activity fee due date is now June 1.
- **Camp: are we going to have camp?**
 - Yes, as of now our full intention is to put on a camp. However, we are asked to not accept payment for camp until after April 15. We will provide further updates if / when anything changes.
- **Fair: Are we going to have a fair?**
 - Yes, as of now the Extension Office and Fair Board have full intention of conducting a 2020 fair.
- **Tagging: How will we get swine and feeder tags, and will we have a goat and sheep tag in?**
 - Stay tuned, we are working as a team to determine the best method to tag animals for 2020. Look for email updates.
