The score will include points from the Outstanding Exhibitor Exam, Wayne County Skillathon Score, Showmanship Placing, Breed Class Placing, and a Record Book Score. 2026 Outstanding Exhibitor Awards Criteria – Dairy Projects

Age divisions:

Senior – ages 15-18 (as of Jan. 1)

Intermediate – ages 12-14 (as of Jan. 1)

Junior – ages 8-11 (as of Jan. 1)

**Age divisions are the same across all species*

- **Outstanding Exhibitor Exam (OEE) (30%)** **30 POINTS**
Member receives 30% of their total OEE score (out of 100 points) toward their OEE score for Outstanding Exhibitor purposes. All exam content will come from your species resource book. Exams will be taken on **July 7 or August 4** at the Wayne County Fair Event Center, or make an appointment with the Extension Office between Jul 7 and August 4. Convert their score to a percentage to 1 decimal. (i.e. OEE score of 95 = 28.5 points. $95 * 30\% = 28.5$).

- **Wayne County Skillathon (20%)** **20 POINTS**
Member receives a score out of 20 for completing skillathon. The following will be graded at skillathon: project book or SAE (for FFA students only), interview questions, interview etiquette, knowledge about projects and hands on activity.

- **Showmanship (30%)** **30 POINTS**

1 st place = 30	6 th place = 25	All others = 20 points
2 nd place = 29	7 th place = 24	
3 rd place = 28	8 th place = 23	
4 th place = 27	9 th place = 22	
5 th place = 26	10 th place = 21	

- **Breed Class Placing (10%)** **10 POINTS**

1 st place = 10	6 th place = 7.5	All others = 5 points
2 nd place = 9.5	7 th place = 7	
3 rd place = 9	8 th place = 6.5	
4 th place = 8.5	9 th place = 6	
5 th place = 8	10 th place = 5.5	

Each exhibitor will select one animal to be shown in a mixed breed class on Tuesday after the colored breed show is finished. Exhibitors participating must be in their show whites. Alternate leadsmen will be permitted for this class, providing the exhibitor communicates with the committee and the leadsmen must be the same age or younger. There will be two classes - one for heifers and one for cows. Cows must be milked out before the start of their class. The placement in this class will be used for the 10% class placing portion of the award – not individual breed class placings.

- **Record Book Score: (10%)** **10 POINTS**
 - *4-H Members books must be turned into the Extension Office by **October 2, 2026**.*
 - *FFA Members see your advisors for book grading.*
