Dear Beginning Sewer:

As a 4-H member enrolled in the *Sew Fun* project you are invited to join us for three days of sewing fun at a *Beginner Sewing Workshop* on June 8 - 10 from 8:30 AM-12:00 PM **OR** 1:00-4:30 PM. These workshops will be held at Fisher Auditorium, OSU Wooster Campus, 1680 Madison Ave., Wooster.

At Beginner Sewing Camp, you will learn about basic sewing equipment, how to use a sewing machine, measurements and pattern fitting, pattern layout, clothing construction, and much more. Members of the Building 10 Committee, Master Clothing Educators and other volunteers will help you complete your *Sew Fun* project from start to finish.

The workshop is limited to a minimum of 5 and maximum of 12 participants per session (morning or afternoon). Preference will be given to those attending the workshop for the first time. If you wish to participate, you must complete the online registration at [go.osu.edu/wcsewing2021](https://go.osu.edu/wcsewing2021). You may pay the \$20.00 registration fee online with a credit or debit card when you complete your registration, or you may bring a check or cash to the Extension office by **May 31**. *Please make checks or money orders payable to OSU Extension*. After you have registered, you will receive a confirmation packet which will include a list of items you'll need to bring with you and other details about the workshop.

To participate in the Sewing Workshop you will need to choose one of the following patterns, which is included in your registration fee. You will receive your pattern the first day of the workshop.

**Skirts – Simplicity #1334\*, #1786, #2286\* or #8662**

**Shorts – Simplicity #1520 or #8817**

**Capris – Simplicity #2469\***

**Pants – Simplicity #1520, #2290, #8672 or #8817**

(\* not pictured in current pattern book but we still have a few on hand; you can view these patterns at <https://wayne.osu.edu/building10> under the Sewing Camp tab)

**Please be sure to indicate your pattern choice on your registration form.**

If you attended one of the Pattern & Fabric Selection Clinics at JoAnn Fabrics in April, your fabric selection has already been approved. For participants whose fabric has not been approved, please contact Marcia Brueck at 330-347-5118. If you are not participating in the sewing camp, you should choose a pattern for a skirt, shorts or pants with a complete elastic waist that is labeled “easy”, “simple”, or “learn to sew”.
